6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring that visible identification cards be  
7 worn by persons soliciting contributions in a public  
8 place."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 11.76 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 11.76.130. SOLICITING CONTRIBUTIONS WITHOUT IDENTIFICATION.

12 (a) A person commits the crime of soliciting money without identifica-  
13 tion if

14 (1) he solicits or demands a contribution of money from  
15 another person in a public place; and

16 (2) he is not wearing a plainly visible identification badge  
17 or card, at least two inches by three inches in size, bearing the fol-  
18 lowing information in clear type or print:

19 (A) his full name;

20 (B) the names and addresses of groups, organizations or  
21 individuals for which the contribution is being solicited, or his  
22 own address if he is soliciting on his own behalf.

23 (b) Soliciting money without identification is a class B mis-  
24 demeanor.
