6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to special individual traction per-
7 mits."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.35.155(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) It is unlawful to operate a motor vehicle with studded tires
11 or tires with chains attached on a paved highway or road from May 1
12 through September 15, inclusive, north of 60° North Latitude and from
13 April 15 through September 30, inclusive, south of 60° North Latitude.
14 The commissioner of public safety shall by emergency order provide for
15 additional lawful operating periods based on unusual seasonal or weather
16 conditions. An emergency order adopted under this section is not sub-
17 ject to the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62). Upon application a
18 special individual traction permit may be issued allowing the operation
19 of a motor vehicle with studded tires or chains at any time at the
20 discretion of the vehicle owner. The fee for the special individual
21 permit is one-third of the annual license tax applicable to that class
22 of vehicle under AS 28.10.421 [AS 28.10.200]. An individual traction
23 permit may be obtained for a school bus as defined in AS 42.15.431(10)
24 without payment of the fee. The department may provide an appropriate
25 sticker or other device identifying the vehicle to which the permit
26 applies.
