6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring school boards to hear the complaint
7 of a member of the public regarding a teacher."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 14.20.176. PUBLIC COMPLAINT. A board of a city or borough
11 school district, or the board of a regional educational attendance area,
12 shall, upon request, afford a person who resides in the school district
13 or attendance area an opportunity to present at a public meeting of the
14 board an allegation of fact, which if true, would be cause for the
15 nonretention or dismissal of a teacher.
