6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to foreign trade zones; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 45 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 77. FOREIGN TRADE ZONES.

11 Sec. 45.77.010. APPLICATION FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF FOREIGN TRADE
12 ZONE. (a) As applicable the following may apply to the United States
13 Department of Commerce to establish, operate, and maintain foreign
14 trade zones as provided in the Foreign Trade Zones Act (19 U.S.C. 81a -
15 19 U.S.C. 81u):

16 (1) the commissioner of commerce and economic development, if
17 the foreign trade zone is to be established, operated and maintained by
18 the state, or a corporation qualified under (3);

19 (2) the local governing body of a municipality by ordinance
20 or resolution, if the foreign trade zone is to be established, operated
21 and maintained by the municipality within its corporate boundaries;

22 (3) those officers of a corporation who may be authorized by
23 law or by the bylaws of the corporation, if they apply through the
24 commissioner of commerce and economic development and in a manner con-
25 sistent with the articles of incorporation of the corporation.

26 * Sec. 2. AS 29.53.020(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

27 (7) inventories located within a foreign trade zone estab-
28 lished under AS 45.77.010, before those inventories are cleared by
29 the United States Customs Service and admitted into domestic commerce.

1 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1980.
