BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 47.25.320(a)(1) is amended to read:

(1) dependent child living with nonneedy relative: for a

child under age 18 who is living in the home of a nonneedy relative,

\$200 [\$150], plus an additional \$200 [\$150] for the second child, and

\$75 [\$50] a child for the third and each additional child.
