7 families with dependent children; and providing for an  
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 47.25.320(a)(1) is amended to read:

11 (1) dependent child living with nonneedy relative: for a  
12 child under age 18 who is living in the home of a nonneedy relative,  
13 \$175 [\$150], plus an additional \$175 [\$150] for the second child, and  
14 \$50 a child for the third and each additional child.

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 47.25.320(a)(2)(A) is amended to read:

16 (A) for a parent and one child under 18, a maximum of  
17 \$400 [\$350];

18 \* Sec. 3. AS 47.25.320 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

19 (d) If benefits under Title XVI of the Social Security Act (42  
20 U.S.C. 1381 - 1385) are increased because of an increase in the cost of  
21 living, the department shall increase the monetary maximums in (a) of  
22 this section by a percentage equal to the percentage increase in bene-  
23 fits under Title XVI.

24 \* Sec. 4. AS 47.25.320(c) is repealed.

25 \* Sec. 5. Sections 1 and 2 of this Act take effect January 1, 1981.

26 \* Sec. 6. Sections 3 - 5 of this Act take effect July 1, 1980.
