6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to parking requirements at construc-  
7 tion sites; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. FINDINGS. The legislature finds that construction work  
10 where 50 or more persons are employed and where the site of the construction  
11 is wholly or partly within 5,000 feet of a public road constitutes a highway  
12 safety hazard unless adequate parking is provided for the persons employed on  
13 the construction site.

14 \* Sec. 2. AS 19 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

15 CHAPTER 28. PARKING REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSTRUCTION SITES.

16 Sec. 19.28.010. PROHIBITION OF CONSTRUCTION WORK WITHOUT PARKING.

17 A person employing 50 or more persons at a construction site a part of  
18 which is within 5,000 feet of the nearest edge of the right-of-way of a  
19 public road or highway may not engage in construction work at the site  
20 unless he provides offstreet parking at the construction site adequate  
21 to provide one vehicle parking space for each employee working at the  
22 construction site. When the Department of Transportation and Public  
23 Facilities determines that the topography of the land will not permit  
24 provision of offstreet parking at the construction site, the department  
25 may issue a waiver of the requirements of this section.

26 Sec. 19.28.020. STOP ORDER. When construction work is in viola-  
27 tion of AS 19.28.010, a peace officer may order the construction work  
28 stopped by notice in writing served on the person engaged in doing or  
29 causing the construction work to be done. A copy of the notice shall be

1 sent to the commissioner of public safety. On receipt of the notice,  
2 the person engaged in doing or causing the construction work to be done  
3 shall stop the construction work until the commissioner of public safety  
4 finds that the requirements of AS 19.28.010 have been complied with.

5 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-  
6 070(c).
