6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to deductible income for determining
7 unemployment insurance benefits; and providing for
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 23.20.362(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) The amount of benefits payable to an insured worker for a
12 week of unemployment which begins in a period for which the insured
13 worker is receiving [A PAYMENT FROM] a pension, annuity, or similar
14 periodic payment which is based on the previous work, whether or not
15 in the base period, of the individual [PLAN OR CONTRACT FOR SERVICE IN
16 EMPLOYMENT COVERED BY THIS CHAPTER], or a payment to compensate him
17 for a dismissal from employment without prior notice or for unused
18 paid [LEAVE-OF-ABSENCE FOR] vacation or holidays, shall be reduced by
19 the amount of the payment or compensation which is attributable to the
20 week of unemployment.

21 * Sec. 2. Section 83, Ch. 9 SLA 1980 is repealed.

22 * Sec. 3. This Act is retroactive to April 1, 1980.

23 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
24 10.070(c).
