BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the act of the President of the United States in invoking the

9

Antiquities Act to close some 56,000,000 acres of Alaska's land to general

10

public use was arbitrary and beyond the intent of the law, and

11

WHEREAS it would be inappropriate for the State of Alaska to participate

12

in this unlawful act, and

13

WHEREAS this unlawful act could not be foreseen at the time the legis-

14

lature approved the budget for fiscal year 1979;

15

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the governor is

16

respectfully requested to direct all employees of the Executive Branch that

17

no state personnel, time, facilities or funds are to be used to enforce, or

18

to assist the Federal Government in enforcing, the Antiquities Act or the

19

federal regulations which implement it; and be it

20

FURTHER RESOLVED that nothing in this resolution concerns in any way the

21

continued enforcement of state law.
