BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the older worker (55 years old and over) can make substantial

9

contributions of benefit to employers; and

10

WHEREAS the older worker brings to employment a degree of expertise,

11

stability, and commitment based on previous years of contribution; and

12

WHEREAS the older worker may have special needs with respect to working

13

conditions and stamina which make part-time employment more reasonable than

14

full-time employment; and

15

WHEREAS many jobs could be performed by part-time employees; and

16

WHEREAS there is increasing economic pressure on older people to supple-

17

ment retirement income;

18

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests

19

the Governor to direct the commissioners of the departments in the executive

20

branch to examine and report to the legislature on the number of older

21

workers in their departments and the number of positions which might reason-

22

ably be filled by older workers on a part-time or flex-time basis.
