2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 16

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 ELEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Directing the Department of Trans-
6 portation and Public Facilities to
7 secure possession of buildings at the
8 Port Heiden White Alice site for
9 educational purposes.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 WHEREAS the Alaska Command will soon vacate and make available as
12 surplus the White Alice site near Port Heiden; and

13 WHEREAS the school board of the Lake and Peninsula School District, a
14 regional educational attendance area of the state's unorganized borough, has
15 adopted a resolution calling on the Alaska State Legislature to secure title
16 to the land and facility; and

17 WHEREAS the Lake and Peninsula School District has a plan to develop the
18 Port Heiden White Alice site as a vocational educational facility for the
19 district;

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is
21 respectfully requested to direct the commissioner of transportation and
22 public facilities to take whatever action may be necessary to secure transfer
23 of the interests of the federal government in the land and buildings at the
24 Port Heiden White Alice site to the State of Alaska; and be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED that, in accordance with AS 14.08.151(b), if officials
26 of the Lake and Peninsula School District request title to the land and
27 buildings owned by the state at the Port Heiden White Alice site, the
28 commissioner shall immediately deliver title to the regional school board.
