Expressing the intent of the legisla-

ture to expeditiously comply with the

1974 capital move initiative.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, in 1974, the people passed an initiative requiring the reloca-

10

tion of the capital and requiring that the relocation begin no later than

11

October 1, 1980; and

WHEREAS, in 1976, the people selected the Willow area as the site for

13

the new capital; and

14

WHEREAS the members of the legislature, as the representatives of the

15

people of Alaska, feel a moral obligation to comply with the expressed wish

16

of the people; and

WHEREAS the time for beginning the relocation of the capital, as

18

expressed by the people of the state, is near at hand;

19

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature intends to expedi-

20

tiously comply with the mandate of the people to begin the relocation of the

21

capital; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the governor is urged to refrain from negotiating

23

long-term office leases or renewals of leases in Juneau so that the reloca-

24

tion process may begin without costly and unnecessary complications.
