BE, IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS it is desirable to improve communications between state offices

9

in Juneau and offices and the public in other regions of the state; and

WHEREAS flexible or expanded hours of work in state offices which have

11

frequent contact with offices and persons in other locations might improve

12

communications with those offices and persons in other time zones; and

13

WHEREAS flexible or expanded working hours could reduce traffic con-

14

gestion and improve employee morale and productivity; and

15

WHEREAS flexible working hours are currently used in some state offices,

16

but not on a systematic or comprehensive basis;

17

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is

18

respectfully requested to direct the Department of Administration to conduct

19

a study evaluating the feasibility of using flexible or expanded working

20

hours in state offices.
