5 Requesting the governor to endorse
6 the United States Department of
7 Labor's decision to establish a Job
8 Corps Center in the state.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the United States Department of Labor has previously identified
11 the need for a Job Corps Center in the State of Alaska; and

12 WHEREAS the United States Department of Labor may now be reassessing its
13 original decision to establish a Job Corps Center in the state; and

14 WHEREAS participation in the programs a Job Corps Center could offer
15 would provide our young people with job training, special instruction, career
16 information, and cultivation of work habits; and

17 WHEREAS the establishment of a Job Corps Center would create up to 80
18 positions for instructors and generate numerous jobs in the private sector;
19 and

20 WHEREAS failure by the state to clearly express its approval and endorse-
21 ment of the decision by the United States Department of Labor to establish a
22 Job Corps Center in the state may mean that the original decision is reversed
23 and that the state will lose these potential benefits;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests
25 the governor to formally endorse the United States Department of Labor's
26 decision to establish a Job Corps Center in Alaska.
