5 Requesting the governor to urge the  
6 United States Department of Labor to  
7 establish a Job Corps Center in the  
8 state.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the United States Department of Labor has previously identified  
11 a possible need for a Job Corps Center in the State of Alaska; and

12 WHEREAS the United States Department of Labor may now be considering  
13 establishing a Job Corps Center in the state; and

14 WHEREAS a Job Corps Center offers young people the opportunity to  
15 participate in programs which include training in job skills, career infor-  
16 mation, and work habits; and

17 WHEREAS the establishment of a Job Corps Center would create up to 80  
18 positions for instructors and generate numerous jobs in the private sector;  
19 and

20 WHEREAS failure by the state to clearly express its support for the  
21 establishment of a Job Corps Center in the state may mean that the United  
22 States Department of Labor will not decide to establish a Job Corps Center  
23 and that the state will lose these potential benefits;

24 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests  
25 the governor to urge the United States Department of Labor to establish a Job  
26 Corps Center in Alaska.
