2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 67

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 ELEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the upgrading of the

6 White Pass & Yukon Route.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the White Pass & Yukon Route is a narrow gauge railroad linking
9 Skagway to Whitehorse, Yukon Territory, Canada; and

10 WHEREAS locomotives and rail cars in general use today are incompatible
11 with narrow gauge railbeds; and

12 WHEREAS it is in the interest of the national defense of both Canada and
13 the United States that this important rail link be as versatile as possible
14 in the event of a national emergency affecting either nation;

15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the United States
16 government is requested to provide a portion of the necessary financing, in
17 cooperation with the Canadian government, to upgrade the White Pass & Yukon
18 Route to a standard gauge railbed; and be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED that the original narrow gauge railbed be left in place
20 and preserved for its historic value.

21 COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Neil
22 Goldschmidt, Secretary of the Department of Transportation; the Honorable
23 Harold Brown, Secretary of the Department of Defense; and to the Honorable
24 Ted Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators, and the Honorable
25 Don Young, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Con-
