Relating to a proposed state-federal

land exchange near Haines.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS an amendment will be proposed in the United States Senate to d-2

9

legislation to provide for an exchange of state land at Haines for federal

10

land elsewhere in Alaska; and

11

WHEREAS it is essential to the social and economic well-being of our

12

communities that the land adjacent to them be available under state and local

13

law for the use and enjoyment of their citizens and not be under the domina-

14

tion and control of federal agencies under federal law; and

15

WHEREAS the proposed land exchange will conflict with at least five of

16

the seven consensus points on d-2 legislation adopted by Alaska; and

17

WHEREAS both the City of Haines and the Borough of Haines have peti-

18

tioned the Governor of Alaska, the Alaska Legislature, and the Alaska Dele-

19

gation in Congress to oppose the proposed land exchange;

20

BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives opposes the proposed

21

land exchange and will not approve the proposed land exchange should it be

22

provided for by the d-2 legislation, if any, enacted by Congress.
