5 Disapproving Executive Order No. 47.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS the governor, under authority of art. III, sec. 23 of the Con-
8 stitution of the State of Alaska, has proposed the transfer of the recording
9 function and the Uniform Commercial Code filing function from the Department
10 of Commerce and Economic Development to the Department of Natural Resources
11 by Executive Order No. 47; and

12 WHEREAS the governor has submitted Executive Order No. 47 to the pre-
13 siding officer of each house of the legislature as required by AS 24.30.-
14 130(b); and

15 WHEREAS art. III, sec. 23 of the Constitution of the State of Alaska
16 provides that unless disapproved within 60 days of a regular session by
17 resolution concurred in by a majority of the members in joint session, an
18 executive order becomes effective at a date thereafter designated by the
19 governor; and

20 WHEREAS it is not in the best interests of the state to transfer the
21 recording function and the Uniform Commercial Code filing function as pro-
22 posed in Executive Order No. 47;

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that Executive Order No.
24 47 is disapproved.
