For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to unemployment insurance; and
7 providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 23.20.362(a) is amended to read:

10

(a) The amount of benefits payable to an insured worker for a week
11 of unemployment which begins in a period for which the insured worker is
12 receiving [A PAYMENT FROM] a pension, annuity, or similar periodic pay-
13 ment which is based on the previous work of the insured worker, in-
14 cluding work performed before the beginning of the insured worker's base
15 period [PLAN OR CONTRACT FOR SERVICE IN EMPLOYMENT COVERED BY THIS
16 CHAPTER], or a payment to compensate him for a dismissal from employment
17 without prior notice or for unused paid [LEAVE OF ABSENCE FOR] vacation
18 or holidays, shall be reduced by the amount of the payment or compensa-
19 tion which is attributable to the week of unemployment.

* Sec. 3. AS 23.20.526(d) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(9) in the employ of

(A) a church or a convention or association of churches;

or

(B) an organization which is operated primarily for
27 religious purposes and which is operated, supervised, controlled,
28 , or principally supported by a church or a convention or associa-
29 tion of churches.
