6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the longevity bonus."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 47.45.010(a) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 (a) A person who is 65 years of age or older who has continuously  
10 maintained a domicile in the territory or state for 25 years, or who has  
11 intermittently maintained a domicile in the territory or state for a  
12 cumulative total of 35 years with no period of absence longer than two  
13 years in length, may apply to the commissioner of administration for  
14 qualification to receive a monthly bonus of \$175.
