BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.05.340(a)(5) is amended to read:

(5) Resident hunting, trapping, and sport fishing license..25

[HOWEVER, THE FEE IS 25 CENTS FOR THE HEAD OF A FAMILY OR A DEPENDENT

MEMBER OF HIS FAMILY OR ONE SOLELY DEPENDENT UPON HIMSELF FOR SUPPORT

13

UPON PROOF PRESENTED BY THE APPLICANT THAT THE APPLICANT

14

(A) IS OBTAINING OR HAS OBTAINED ASSISTANCE DURING THE

15

PRECEDING SIX MONTHS UNDER ANY STATE OR FEDERAL WELFARE PROGRAM TO

16

AID THE INDIGENT, OR

17

(B) HAS AN ANNUAL FAMILY GROSS INCOME OF LESS THAN

18

\$3,600 FOR THE YEAR PRECEDING APPLICATION.]

(b) A fee for a sport fishing, hunting or trapping license is not

21

required of a resident who is 60 years of age or more and has been a

22

resident for 15 [30] consecutive years or more, as long as he remains a

23

resident. The commissioner of revenue shall issue a permanent license

24

without charge to persons who qualify by age and residency upon comple-

25

tion of appropriate forms as the commissioner may require for implemen-

26

tation of this subsection.
