Sec. 16.05.390. FEE FOR ISSUANCE OF LICENSES AND TAGS. A person appointed and authorized by the commissioner of revenue to sell licenses and tags, except a salaried employee of the state, is entitled to keep five per cent of the fee for the issuance of each license or tag, or a fee of 25 cents, whichever is greater. The authorized person is entitled to reimbursement from the Department of Revenue in the amount of \$1 for each resident hunting, trapping and sport fishing license issued

1 under AS 16.05.400(b). Each person selling licenses or tags shall, as
2 soon as practicable after the last day of each calendar month, transmit
3 the proceeds from the sales, except the amount authorized to be
4 retained, together with a report of the sales to the commissioner for
5 deposit in the fish and game fund or the general fund. Fees imposed
6 under AS 16.05.340(e) shall be collected and transmitted in the same
7 manner and to the same source as license and tag fees provided for under
8 this chapter.
