A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act granting a preference to purchase state land to
7 persons honorably discharged from the Alaska Army or
8 Air National Guard; and providing for an effective
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 38.05.067(d) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

12 (d) In this section "veteran" means a person with

13 (1) 90 days or more of active service in the armed forces of
14 the United States who has been honorably discharged after having served
15 between

16 (A) April 6, 1917, and December 1, 1919,

17 (B) September 16, 1940, and December 31, 1947,

18 (C) June 27, 1950, and January 31, 1955, or

19 (D) August 4, 1964, and November 7, 1975; or

20 (2) not less than six years service in the Alaska Army Na-
21 tional Guard or the Alaska Air National Guard who has been honorably
22 discharged, or a person with less than six years of service because of
23 injury or disability incurred in the line of duty who has been honorably
24 discharged.

25 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1979.
