6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to pipeline tariffs; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 42.06.400(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) When a tariff filing is made containing an initial or revised
11 rate, classification, rule, regulation, practice, or condition of
12 service the commission may, either upon written complaint or upon its
13 own motion, after reasonable notice, conduct a hearing to determine
14 the reasonableness and propriety of the filing. Pending a hearing the
15 commission may, by order stating the reasons for its action, suspend
16 the operation of the tariff filing for an initial period not longer
17 than six months beyond the time when it would otherwise go into effect.
18 If good cause is shown, the commission may suspend the operation of
19 the tariff filing for an additional period not to exceed one year
20 following the end of the initial suspension period. If information on
21 which to base a just and reasonable tariff is lacking or incomplete at
22 the close of the second suspension period, the commission may, for
23 good cause shown, with or without a hearing, order the original filed
24 rate to be collected like a temporary tariff in accordance with (c)
25 of this section, subject to refund of the difference between the filed
26 rate and the final rate, until a final rate can be set.
