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A BILL

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For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to pipeline tariffs; and providing
7 for an effective date."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

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* Section 1. AS 42.06.400(a) is amended to read:

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(a) When a tariff filing is made containing an initial or revised rate, classification, rule, regulation, practice, or condition of service the commission may, either upon written complaint or upon its own motion, after reasonable notice, conduct a hearing to determine the reasonableness and propriety of the filing. Pending a hearing the commission may, by order stating the reasons for its action, suspend the operation of the tariff filing for an initial period not longer than six months beyond the time when it would otherwise go into effect. If good cause is shown, the commission may suspend the operation of the tariff filing for an additional period not to exceed one year following the end of the initial suspension period. If information on which to base a just and reasonable tariff is lacking or incomplete at the close of the second suspension period, the commission may, during the suspension period and for good cause shown, with or without a hearing, order the filed rate to be collected, subject to refund of the difference between the filed rate and the final rate, until a final rate can be set. The commission may order the difference between the temporary tariff established under this section and the filed rate to be placed in escrow or secured by bond pending establishment of the final rate.
