6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to increase of fees and licenses ad-
7 ministered by division of insurance."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 (a) Duplicate copies of legal process against an insurer for
11 whom the director is attorney under sec. 180 of this chapter shall be
12 served upon the director, or upon his deputy or other person in charge
13 of his office during his absence. At the time of service the plain-
14 tiff shall pay \$15 [\$5] to the director taxable as costs in the action.
15 Upon receiving service the director shall promptly forward a copy by
16 certified mail with return receipt requested to the person last desig-
17 nated by the insurer to receive it.

19 (b) A statement containing the information outlined in sec. 20 of

29 Sec. 21.84.030. ANNUAL LICENSE. [SOCIETIES WHICH ARE NOW AUTHO-

1 RIZED TO TRANSACT BUSINESS IN THIS STATE MAY CONTINUE THE BUSINESS UN-
2 TIL JULY 1, 1967.] The authority of [THE] societies [AND ALL SOCIE-
3 TIES HEREAFTER] licensed[,] may [THEREAFTER] be renewed annually, but
4 in all cases terminates [TERMINATE] on the first day of the succeeding
5 July. However, a license so issued continues [SHALL CONTINUE] in full
6 force and effect until the new license is issued or specifically re-
7 fused. For each license or renewal the society shall pay the director
8 a fee as specified in AS 21.06.250(a)(1) for certificates of authority
9 [\$15]. A certified copy or duplicate of the license shall be prima
10 facie evidence that the licensee is a fraternal benefit society within
11 the meaning of this chapter.
