6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the authority of the Alaska Trans-
7 portation Commission over joint carrier agreements."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 42.10.070 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (6) shall implement the policies and objectives expressed in
11 AS 42.10.010 by adopting regulations authorizing agreements between
12 common carriers relating to rates, classifications, divisions, allow-
13 ances, and the pooling or division of traffic, services, earnings or
14 profits; however, the commission may not authorize an agreement

15 (A) between a carrier by highway and a carrier by rail,
16 water, or air unless it is limited to matters relating to trans-
17 portation under joint rates or over through routes; or

18 (B) which establishes a procedure for the determination
19 of a matter through joint consideration unless the commission finds
20 that there is accorded to each party the free and unrestrained
21 right to take independent action either before or after a determi-
22 nation made through such a procedure.

24 (e) This chapter does not apply to carriers, their organizations,
25 associations or agents regulated under AS 42.10, AS 42.15, and AS 02.05,
26 or to ferries regulated under AS 42.25.
