5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the civil liability of gratuitous
7 servers of alcoholic beverages."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. The legislature declares that the gratuitous social fur-
10 nishing of alcoholic beverages to an individual may not be held to be the
11 proximate cause of injuries sustained by that individual or inflicted by that
12 individual on a third party.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 09.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

14 Sec. 09.65.097. LIMITATIONS ON THE CIVIL LIABILITY OF GRATUITOUS
15 BEVERAGE SERVERS. (a) A person who gratuitously furnishes an alcoholic
16 beverage to an individual may not be held civilly liable for injuries
17 resulting from the intoxication of that individual.

18 (b) The protections of this section do not apply to a person
19 licensed under the provisions of AS 04, or to an employee or agent of a
20 person licensed under the provisions of AS 04, who gratuitously fur-
21 nishes an alcoholic beverage on a premises licensed under AS 04.
