6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Public Employment Relations
7 Act; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.40.200(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) The class in (a)(1) of this section is composed of police
11 and fire protection employees, jail, prison and other correctional
12 institution employees, [AND] hospital employees, and employees of the
13 Alaska Division of Emergency Services. Employees in this class may
14 not engage in strikes. Upon a showing by a public employer or the
15 labor relations agency that employees in this class are engaging or
16 about to engage in a strike, an injunction, restraining order, or
17 other order which may be appropriate shall be granted by the superior
18 court in the judicial district in which the strike is occurring or is
19 about to occur. If an impasse or deadlock is reached in collective
20 bargaining between the public employer and employees in this class,
21 and mediation has been utilized without resolving the deadlock, the
22 parties shall submit to arbitration to be carried out under AS 09.43.-
23 030.

24 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
25 10.070(c).
