6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing a permit system for regulated
7 motor vehicles engaged in transportation of other motor
8 vehicles."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 42.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 ARTICLE 5. VEHICLE CARRIER TRANSPORTATION PERMITS.

12 Sec. 42.30.200. VEHICLE CARRIER TRANSPORTATION PERMITS. (a) The
13 Alaska Transportation Commission shall, by regulation, provide for the
14 issuance of annual permits for motor carriers engaged in the transporta-
15 tion of vehicles. The regulations adopted by the commission shall
16 include, but are not limited to, provisions authorizing use of the
17 public highways by motor carriers which include vehicle transport
18 trailers or semi-trailers used for motor vehicle transport which are
19 "stinger-steered", of a maximum length of 85 feet and maximum height of
20 15.5 feet, when laden, and of a maximum length of 70 feet when un-
21 laden, and without limitation as to hours of operation or movement or
22 area of service.

23 (b) In this section, "stinger-steered" means a semi-trailer or
24 vehicle transportation trailer coupled to a towing vehicle by a device
25 located to the rear of the center line of the rearmost axle of the
26 towing vehicle.
