6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing a permit system for regulated
7 motor vehicles engaged in transportation of other motor
8 vehicles."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 42.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 ARTICLE 5. VEHICLE CARRIER TRANSPORTATION PERMITS.

12 Sec. 42.30.200. VEHICLE CARRIER TRANSPORTATION PERMITS. (a) The
13 Commissioner of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities
14 shall, by regulation, provide for the issuance of annual permits for
15 motor carriers engaged in the transportation of vehicles. The regula-
16 tions adopted by the commission shall include, but are not limited to,
17 provisions authorizing use of the public highways by motor carriers
18 which include vehicle transport trailers or semi-trailers used for motor
19 vehicle transport which are "stinger-steered", of a maximum length of 85
20 feet and maximum height of 15.5 feet, when laden, and of a maximum
21 length of 70 feet when unladen, and without limitation as to hours of
22 operation or movement or area of service.

23 (b) In this section, "stinger-steered" means a semi-trailer or
24 vehicle transportation trailer coupled to a towing vehicle by a device
25 located to the rear of the center line of the rearmost axle of the
26 towing vehicle.
