6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to marine pilots; and providing for an
7 effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.62.190 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 08.62.190. PENALTY. A master or owner of a vessel required
11 by this chapter to employ a licensed pilot who fails to do so when a
12 licensed pilot is available, unless the perils or hazards of the sea
13 prevent the employment of a pilot, is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon
14 conviction, is punishable by a fine of not less than \$1,000 [\$500] nor
15 more than \$5,000 [\$1,000]. A person who violates any other provision of
16 this chapter or a regulation adopted under it is guilty of a misdemeanor
17 and, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine of not less than \$500 nor
18 more than \$1,000.
