6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing a legislative internship program."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 24.20.060 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

9 (8) to establish a legislative internship program on a co-  
10 operative basis with a postsecondary educational institution, by provid-  
11 ing for the assignment of one intern to each standing committee of each  
12 house of the legislature; students enrolled in accredited postsecondary  
13 educational institutions are eligible to participate in the program; for  
14 his participation in the program, a student is entitled to receive both  
15 academic credit and payment of an amount not less than the minimum wage  
16 established under AS 23.10.065.
