5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the determination of residency for  
7 purposes of fish and game licensing."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 16.05.940(14) is amended to read:

10 (14) "resident" means a person who for 12 consecutive months  
11 resides in the state with the intention of making his permanent dwelling  
12 in the state; residence may not be lost solely by reason of the person's  
13 absence while in the civil or military service of this state or of the  
14 United States, while a student at an institution of learning, while in a  
15 mental institution, while confined in prison, while engaged in the navi-  
16 gation of waters of this state, of the United States or of the high  
17 seas, or while holding elected public office; a person may not be a resi-  
18 dent of more than one state at a time; a person who purchases a resident  
19 hunting or fishing license in another state, permanently resides in  
20 another state, votes in another state, enrolls in an educational insti-  
21 tution as a resident of another state, or accepts a privilege of resi-  
22 dency in another state which is not available for nonresidents in that  
23 state is not a resident for the purposes of this chapter; purchasing,  
24 leasing or renting a permanent place of abode in the state is evidence  
25 of an intent to establish residence but is not in and of itself deter-  
26 minative; a permanent place of abode does not include a mobile vessel,  
27 vehicle or motorhome [HAS MAINTAINED A PERMANENT PLACE OF ABODE IN THE  
28 STATE AND WHO HAS CONTINUALLY MAINTAINED HIS VOTING RESIDENCE IN THE  
29 STATE]; and in the case of a partnership, association, joint stock

1 company, trust, or corporation, "resident" means one that has its main  
2 office or headquarters in the state [; HOWEVER, A MEMBER OF THE MILITARY  
3 SERVICE WHO HAS BEEN STATIONED IN THE STATE FOR THE PRECEDING 12 CONSE-  
4 CUTIVE MONTHS IS A RESIDENT FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS CHAPTER, AND THE  
5 DEPENDENT OF A RESIDENT MEMBER OF THE MILITARY SERVICE, WHO HAS BEEN  
6 LIVING IN THE STATE FOR THE PRECEDING YEAR IS A RESIDENT FOR THE PUR-  
7 POSES OF THIS CHAPTER, AND A PERSON WHO IS AN ALIEN BUT WHO FOR ONE YEAR  
8 HAS MAINTAINED A PERMANENT PLACE OF ABODE IN THE STATE IS A RESIDENT FOR  
9 THE PURPOSES OF THIS CHAPTER];
