6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to public employment; and providing  
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 39.27 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 Sec. 39.27.019. DIFFERENTIALS OUTSIDE THE STATE. An employee of  
11 the state who is not covered by a collective bargaining agreement and  
12 whose duty station is located outside the state shall be paid a salary  
13 which is six pay steps below the rate established for his position in  
14 the basic salary schedule (AS 39.27.011).

15 Sec. 39.27.021. GEOGRAPHIC PAY DIFFERENTIALS PROHIBITED. No pay  
16 differentials based on geographic location in the state or on cost-of-  
17 living differences in areas of the state shall be allowed after July 1,  
18 1979. This section applies to state employees paid under AS 37.27.011.  
19 This section also applies to those state employees covered by collective  
20 bargaining agreements which are negotiated after July 1, 1979.

21 \* Sec. 2. AS 39.25.155(e) is amended to read:

22 (e) The director of personnel shall embody a concept combined of  
23 technical ability, place of residence, local hire and area unemployment  
24 in the personnel rules to accomplish the intent of this section and  
25 shall provide for a method by which the appointing authority is en-  
26 couraged to appoint a resident of a region of the state where unemploy-  
27 ment or underemployment is relatively severe to fill a job vacancy in  
28 that region regardless of his ranking on the eligible list relative to  
29 nonresidents of that region.

1 \* Sec. 3. AS 39.25.155 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:  
2 (h) The director of personnel and labor relations shall prepare an  
3 annual report to the legislature on the progress of the vocational  
4 substitution program and shall deliver the report within the first 10  
5 days of each legislative session.  
6 \* Sec. 4. AS 39.27.020 is repealed.  
7 \* Sec. 5. This Act takes effect July 1, 1979.

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
