6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to medical, annual, and personal
7 leave."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.35 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 Sec. 39.35.355. REINSTATED MEDICAL LEAVE. If an employee's em-
11 ployment is terminated for any reason before he becomes eligible for a
12 retirement benefit and the employee is subsequently reemployed within
13 three years by the same employer, the employee is entitled to have
14 reinstated in full the medical leave he had accumulated at the time of
15 his last termination.

16 Sec. 39.35.365. MEDICAL LEAVE COMPUTED AS CREDITED SERVICE. Upon
17 retirement, an employee is entitled to receive credited service for his
18 accumulated medical leave. For purposes of determining his credited
19 service for the entire period of employment, the employee's medical
20 leave shall be computed as credited service at the same rate of pay as
21 his salary on retirement.

22 Sec. 39.35.375. OPTION FOR ANNUAL OR PERSONAL LEAVE COMPUTED AS
23 CREDITED SERVICE. Upon retirement, an employee shall have the option to
24 receive credited service for his accumulated annual or personal leave or
25 receive cash payment for his accumulated annual or personal leave. For
26 purposes of determining his credited service for the entire period of
27 employment, the employee's annual or personal leave shall be computed as
28 credited service at the same rate of pay as his salary on retirement.

29 Sec. 39.35.377. CREDITED SERVICE FOR MEDICAL LEAVE. A vested
