6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the maximum period of work for
7 certain employees."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 23.10.072. MAXIMUM PERIOD OF WORK FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES. An
11 employer (1) who furnishes lodging to an employee for the convenience of
12 the employer and (2) who requires the employee to accept the lodging as
13 a condition of employment may not allow the employee to work for a
14 period longer than seven consecutive days at a time. Each work period
15 of seven consecutive days must be followed by a rest period of seven
16 consecutive days. This section does not apply to employment found by
17 the commissioner to be of a seasonal nature.
