6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to expenditure of state money; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Section 2, 1978 Ballot Proposition No. 3, is amended to
10 read:

11 Section 2. CAPITAL RELOCATION EXPENDITURES. State money may be
12 expended to relocate physically the present functions of the state
13 government, including but not limited to, the legislature, the gover-
14 nor's office and all offices of the heads of the principal departments
15 from their present location only after a majority of those voting in a
16 statewide election have approved a bond issue which includes all bonded
17 [BONDABLE] costs of the relocation to the State through the year 1986
18 [1992], as determined by a commission created by the legislature to plan
19 the relocation. In determining the bonded [BONDABLE] costs to the State
20 the commission shall also determine the total costs to the State. Those
21 costs shall include, but not be limited to, the costs of moving person-
22 nel and offices to the relocation site; the social, economic and environ-
23 mental costs to the present and relocation sites; and, the cost to the
24 State of planning, building, furnishing, using and financing a new
25 capital city [HAVING FACILITIES EQUAL TO THOSE PROVIDED BY THE PRESENT
26 CAPITAL CITY AND THOSE REQUIRED BY THE 1974 CAPITAL MOVE INITIATIVE].

27 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
