6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the transporter law; and providing  
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.54.144(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) Air carriers who transport persons between airports, landing  
11 strips or other landing areas officially listed in the United States  
12 government Flight Information Publication, Alaska Supplement, as re-  
13 vised, or the United States government Sectional Aeronautical Charts, as  
14 revised, are exempted from the license requirements for transporters  
15 under this chapter [BUT SHALL COMPLY WITH THE REPORTING PROVISIONS AS  
16 PRESCRIBED IN AS 02.05.170(f)].

17 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.54.144(c) is amended to read:

18 (c) Master guides, registered guides, class-A assistant guides or  
19 assistant guides are exempted from the license requirements for trans-  
20 porters under this chapter [BUT SHALL COMPLY WITH THE REPORTING PROVI-  
21 SIONS AS PRESCRIBED IN AS 02.05.170(f)].
