BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 09.55 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 09.55.045. PRESUMPTION OF DEATH WITHOUT JURY VERDICT. If a  
10 petition is presented by an interested person to a district judge or  
11 magistrate alleging that a designated person has disappeared and after  
12 diligent search cannot be found, and if it appears to the satisfaction  
13 of the judge or magistrate that the missing person has not been heard  
14 from for a period of six consecutive years, the missing person is pre-  
15 sumed to be dead and the judge or magistrate shall enter an order to  
16 that effect.
