6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to injury leave; and providing for an  
7 effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 29.13.100 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (40) AS 29.23.552 (injury leave for municipal officers and  
11 employees).

12 \* Sec. 2. AS 29.23 is amended by adding a new section to read:

13 Sec. 29.23.552. INJURY LEAVE. The assembly or council shall adopt  
14 by ordinance a program of injury leave for municipal officers and  
15 employees. The program shall be the same as provided for state officers  
16 and employees under AS 39.20.265.

17 \* Sec. 3. AS 39.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

18 Sec. 39.20.265. INJURY LEAVE. (a) An officer or employee who  
19 incurs an injury in the course of his employment with the state is  
20 entitled to injury leave. The officer or employee may take injury leave  
21 until the injury has been treated and he is physically able to return to  
22 his employment. While taking injury leave, an officer or employee is  
23 entitled to his full pay and benefits. An officer or employee who is  
24 entitled to injury leave under this section is not required to take  
25 personal or banked medical leave as a prerequisite to taking injury  
26 leave.

27 (b) The taking of injury leave with pay and benefits shall be  
28 reduced by the amount of wage continuation payments made under the  
29 Alaska Workmen's Compensation Act (AS 23.30).

1       \* Sec. 4. Section 3 of this Act takes effect immediately in accordance  
2 with AS 01.10.070(c). Sections 1 and 2 of this Act take effect 90 days after  
3 the effective date of sec. 3 of this Act.
