6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring the preparation of a local government
7 impact statement."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.62 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 44.62.195. LOCAL GOVERNMENT IMPACT STATEMENT. If the adop-
11 tion, amendment, or repeal of a regulation would result in a change in
12 the amount of revenue available to, or the expenditures required of, a
13 municipality, the department or agency proposing to adopt, amend, or
14 repeal the regulation shall prepare an impact statement. In the state-
15 ment the department or agency shall identify and describe the direct and
16 indirect effects on the municipality of the adoption, amendment, or
17 repeal of the regulation.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 44.62.200(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

19 (5) a summary of the local government impact statement re-
20 quired under AS 44.62.195.

21 * Sec. 3. AS 44.62.320(b) is amended to read:

22 (b) At the same time a regulation is filed by the lieutenant
23 governor, the lieutenant governor shall submit the regulation to the
24 chairman of the Administrative Regulation Review Committee for review
25 under AS 24.20.400 - 24.20.460 together with any local government impact
26 statement required under AS 44.62.195.
