6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing Medicaid-reimbursable assistance
7 payments for persons who are 'medically needy'; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 47.07.020(b) is amended by adding a new paragraph to
11 read:

12 (8) aged, blind or disabled persons who do not receive an
13 optional state supplementary payment under the old age assistance pro-
14 gram (AS 47.25.430 - 47.25.610), the aid to the blind program (AS 47.-
15 25.620 - 47.25.780), or the aid to the permanently and totally disabled
16 program (AS 47.25.790 - 47.25.970) because their incomes exceed the
17 income standards of those programs, but who have incurred medical expen-
18 ses which equal or exceed the difference between the monthly income and
19 the income standard applicable under the state supplementary program for
20 which the person in this group would otherwise qualify.

21 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1980.
