6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the acquisition of land by the
7 United States; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 38.05 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 ARTICLE 15. ACQUISITION OF LAND BY THE UNITED STATES.

11 Sec. 38.05.500. CONSENT TO ACQUISITION OF LAND BY THE UNITED
12 STATES. (a) The consent of this state is given, in accordance with
13 Section 8 of Article I of the Constitution of the United States, to the
14 acquisition by the United States, by purchase, condemnation or other-
15 wise, of land in the state required for sites for custom houses, post
16 offices, arsenals, forts, magazines, dockyards, military reserves,
17 irrigation or drainage projects, municipal water facilities or for
18 needful public buildings. The consent of the state is also given to the
19 acquisition of land in the state by the United States for the purpose of
20 consolidation within existing boundaries of national forests in the
21 state, by purchase, gift or exchange or by condemnation with the consent
22 of the owner.

23 (b) Land in the state which is outside of an incorporated munici-
24 pality and which is being considered for acquisition for a purpose other
25 than those described in (a) of this section may be acquired by the
26 United States only with the consent of a majority of each house of the
27 state legislature.

28 Sec. 38.05.510. CONSTRUCTION. The provisions of AS 38.05.500 may
29 not be construed as constituting consent by the state legislature to the
