\* Sec. 2. AS 43.80 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 43.80.035. REPORTING OF SALMON PRICES. (a) The commissioner may

(1) issue subpoenas under AS 43.05.040 to compel the testimony of witnesses and the production of records and documents necessary to obtain and audit reports and information on wholesale prices of salmon when required by AS 44.25.020(5);

(2) levy and collect a civil penalty for failure to report information on wholesale prices of salmon when required by AS 44.25.020(5).

(b) A person who fails to file a report containing information on the wholesale prices of salmon when required by the commissioner under AS 44.25.020(5) is liable for a civil penalty of \$5,000. The penalty shall be assessed and collected in the same manner as taxes are assessed and collected under this title.
