SENATE BILL NO. 361
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
ELEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION
A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing the sale of state flags which have
flown over the state capitol."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 44.09 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 44.09.035. STATE FLAGS FLOWN OVER THE CAPITOL. The commis-
sioner of transportation and public facilities shall make available to
members of the public official state flags which he certifies have flown
over the state capitol. The date on which the flag was flown over the
state capitol shall be specified in the certification. A person may,
by request to the commissioner at least 30 days in advance, request a
flag flown over the capitol on a specific date. The commissioner may
collect a reasonable fee for the flag.
