6 For an Act entitled: "An Act imposing penalties on persons who deal in  
7 intoxicating liquors without a license; and providing  
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 04.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 04.15.095. PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS BY UNLICENSED PERSONS. A  
12 person who violates AS 04.10.010 is, upon conviction, guilty of

13 (1) a misdemeanor and punishable by imprisonment for not more  
14 than one year, or by a fine of not more than \$5,000, or by both;

15 (2) a felony and punishable by imprisonment for not more than  
16 six years, or by a fine of not more than \$30,000, or by both, if, in  
17 addition to the manufacture, sale, offer for sale, possession for sale,  
18 trafficking in, barter, or exchange for goods,

19 (A) the prohibited conduct involved a sale, barter, or  
20 exchange to a person under the age of 19 years; or

21 (B) the person had previously been convicted under this  
22 section.

23 \* Sec. 2. AS 04.15.100(a) is amended to read:

24 (a) A person who violates any provision of this title other than  
25 AS 04.10.010 or AS 04.15.080 is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon con-  
26 viction is punishable by imprisonment of not more than one year, or by a  
27 fine of not more than \$500. Each violation is a separate offense.
