6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring identification on entry permits; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.43.180 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (c) If an entry permit is transferred under this section, the
11 commission shall issue a tag indicating the name and address of the
12 transferee and the period during which the transfer is effective. The
13 transferee shall affix the tag to the entry permit before using the
14 entry permit.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 16.43 is amended by adding a new section to read:

16 Sec. 16.43.375. PHOTOGRAPHS ON ENTRY PERMITS. (a) An entry
17 permit issued under this chapter shall display a photograph of the
18 person to whom the entry permit is issued.

19 (b) If an entry permit is transferred under AS 16.43.150(h) or
20 under AS 16.43.170(b), the transferee shall submit the entry permit to
21 the commission. The commission shall replace the photograph on the
22 entry permit with a photograph of the transferee and return the entry
23 permit to the transferee.

24 * Sec. 3. By July 1, 1981, the Alaska Commercial Fisheries Entry Commis-
25 sion shall replace or modify entry permits issued under AS 16.43 before the
26 effective date of this Act to bring them into conformity with the provisions
27 of AS 16.43.375 enacted in sec. 2 of this Act.

28 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1980.
