10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The lieutenant governor shall place before the qualified voters of the state at the next general election a question advisory to the legislature of whether the legislature should enact laws which would raise the age of majority from 19 to 21 years for the purpose of regulation of the sale, consumption, service, furnishing, barter, purchase, gift, or delivery of intoxicating liquor. The question shall appear on the ballot in the following form:
