6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing a state holiday."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 44.12.010 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 44.12.010. LEGAL HOLIDAYS. The following days are legal  
10 holidays: (1) the first of January, known as New Year's Day; (2) the  
11 12th of February, known as Lincoln's Birthday; (3) the third Monday in  
12 February, known as Washington's Birthday; (4) the last Monday of March,  
13 known as Seward's Day; (5) the last Monday in May, known as Memorial  
14 Day; (6) the fourth of July, known as Independence Day; (7) the first  
15 Monday in September, known as Labor Day; (8) the eighteenth of October,  
16 known as Alaska Day; (9) the 11th of November, known as Veterans' Day;  
17 (10) the fourth Thursday in November, known as Thanksgiving Day; (11)  
18 the 25th of December, known as Christmas Day; (12) every Sunday; (13)  
19 every day designated by public proclamation by the President of the  
20 United States or the governor of the state as a legal holiday; (14)  
21 the Tuesday after the first Monday in November in presidential election  
22 years.
